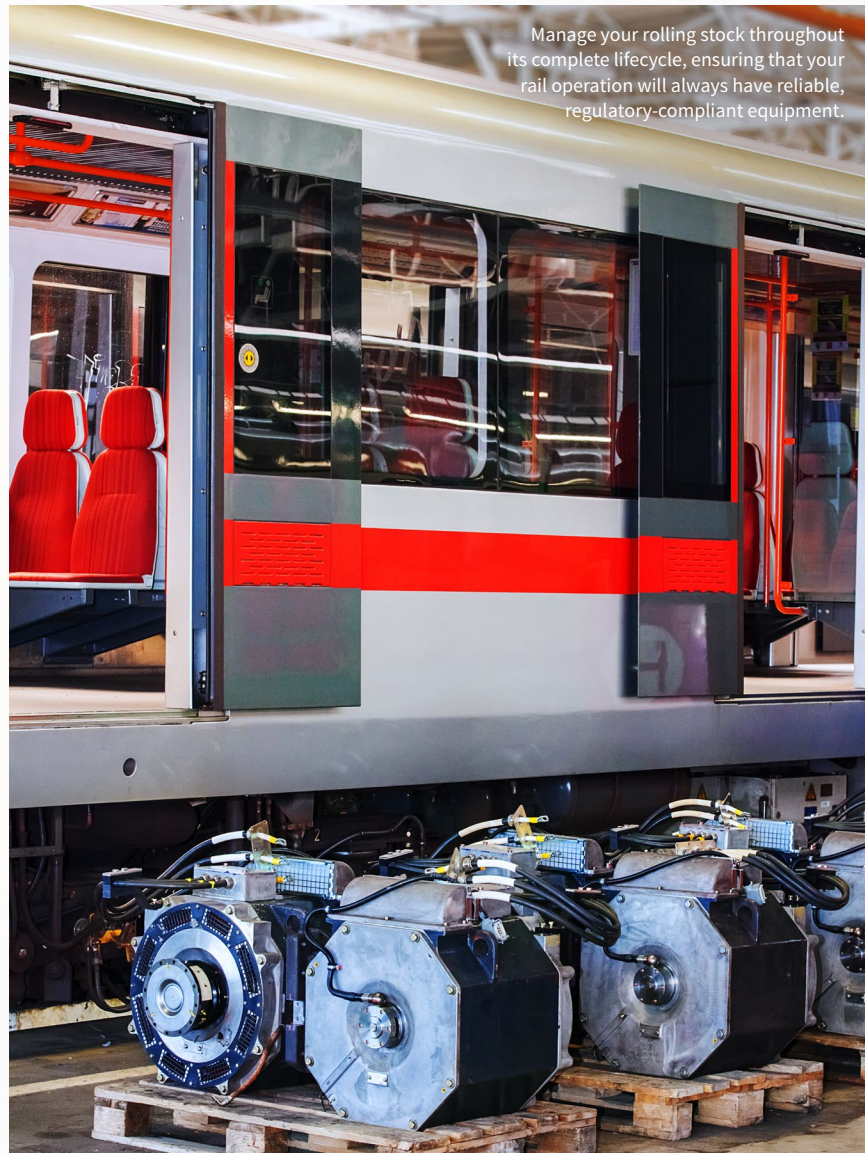

Right of Way (ROW) or linear asset management is a high-stakes part of your rail operations. Top agencies excel at striking the crucial balance between having safe, reliable rail corridors and creating innovative solutions to reduce maintenance costs and assure maximum asset availability.

The Trapeze Rail Enterprise EAM software helps manage key aspects of the right-of-way, including inspections, defect recording and repairs of tracks, signals, switches, catenary and wayside systems and equipment. Our comprehensive solution stores data in a single database and offers real-time access to information, allowing users to make timely decisions about maintenance practices, capital improvements, train scheduling and rail operations system-wide.

FUELFOCUS

For rail agencies incorporating diesel locomotives or multiple units, our FuelFocus System enables wireless data transmission between a vehicle equipped with an RF Vehicle Box and the FuelFocus Controller. The vehicle is automatically identified when the nozzle is inserted into the fuel tank inlet.
